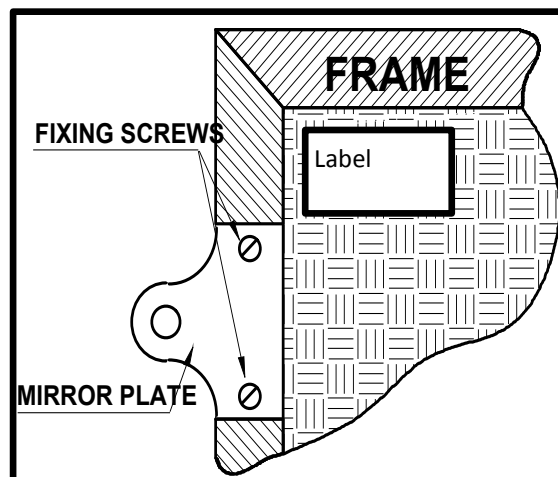
Plein Air Painting Days

Meet up in the grounds for both or just one of our plein air painting days in the spectacular grounds of Himley Hall.

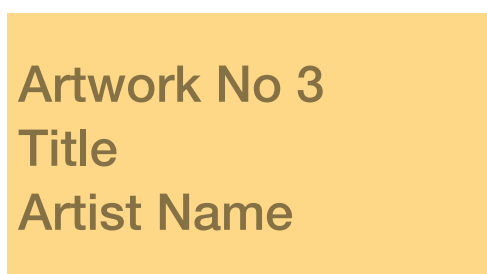
Lets make this a social event, bring a picnic lunch & cake for afternoon tea

1. Himley Hall has a quantity of rigid boards for the display of framed, glazed artwork.
2. Exhibits to be hung on rigid boards must be framed. Please ensure that any framed photographs or paintings have mirror plates attached to the frames to allow for displaying on our panels (see below how to fit mirror plates).
3. Please note, all exhibits in the Corridor Galleries must be framed with glass (not perspex) and oil paintings cannot be displayed.
4. Mirror Plates must be screwed to the back of all pictures one third of the way from the top and left covered to prevent damage to other works.



5. Himley Hall will produce title cards based on the information provided from your Submission form (title, medium, size, price for sale, and artists name).
6. Himley Hall add 40% to your artists price, be aware that their insurance based on £1000 per item.
7. All exhibits will need to be numbered on the reverse (or by a removable tag) in order for them to be identified on the inventory list by Himley Hall's Exhibition Officer.

8. The label must match the number of your artwork titles on your submission form.
9. Please note that exhibitors cannot submit exhibits previously shown at Himley Hall within the last two years.
10. On delivery and collection we ask that you sign a copy of our inventory sheet, to show that it accurately reflects the items you are delivering/collecting.
11. Please note that any discrepancies must be brought to the attention of Himley Hall staff at the time of delivery/collection.
12. Sales are paid by Dudley Council normally six weeks after the exhibition closes.
13. The total sales are paid to the Walsall Society of Artists, once in receipt of the payment, the WSA Treasurer will be in touch to pay the individual artists.
14. At no point should individual artists contact Himley Hall or Dudley Council re payments for sales made during the exhibition.
